This permit authorizes open burning at the above site and at the approved date and time only. This permit is only valid if the following conditions are met:

1. No fire shall be closer than 150 feet from occupied buildings.
2. No fire shall be closer than 50 feet from a public road.
3. No fire shall be closer than 25 feet from forests.
4. No fire shall be closer than 25 feet from your home.
5. No fire shall be bigger than 8 feet in diameter or it must be in a non-combustible container covered with a wire mesh to prevent sparks from flying out.
6. Open burning must be attended at all times.
7. Burn will only be conducted when prevailing winds direct the smoke away from the public highway or road.
8. Extinguishing equipment must be on site, available and ready for use.
9. The responsible individual must be at least 21 years old.
10. The property owner is required to contact all necessary agencies to report their intent to burn once this permit is signed (Archer Fire Department: 352-495-2333, Florida Division of Forestry)
11. Applicant must be the property owner or have written permission from the property owner.
- 12. A permit will not be issued if Alachua County has a "no burn order" in effect.**

This permit may be withdrawn if any conditions to burn are not met. The City of Archer maintains the authority to cease any burn at any time.
