

## Chapter 16

### POLICE\*

#### Sec. 16-1. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The city commission with the consent of the mayor may appoint police officers, including those of the county, to enforce this Code and other ordinances of the city. (Code 1971, § 2-4)

#### Sec. 16-2. ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS FOR POLICE TRAINING

- a) Pursuant to the authority granted by F.S. § 943.25, the county court shall levy the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) as court cost against every person convicted in such court for any offense committed in the city. In addition, one dollar (\$1.00) from every bond estreature or forfeited bail bond shall be collected and used as hereinafter provided.
- b) The amount of the fine in each instance and the amount of the bail bond in each instance shall be increased in order that the additional sum of one dollar (\$1.00) herein required shall be paid over and above the amount or amounts otherwise required.
- c) All such sums collected shall be deposited by the court in an appropriate bank account and shall be accounted for separate and apart from any other funds of the court. Such funds so collected and separately accounted for shall be used by the city only for law enforcement education purposes in connection with the education of the law enforcement officers of the city.
