BUILDINGS AND BUILDING REGULATIONS

(SEE BUILDING CODE ADOPTED BY ALACHUA COUNTY)

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

ARTICLE II. BUILDING CODE*

Sec. 6-19. ADOPTION OF STANDARD BUILDING CODE

- a) There is hereby adopted by reference the Building Code, as adopted by Alachua County, subject however to such amendments and additions which may appear elsewhere in this article and except insofar as such provisions, by their very nature, could have no application in the city.

Sec. 6-20. BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED

It shall be unlawful for any person to construct any building or structure to be used for private use, a residence, place of employment, or service to the public without first obtaining a building permit from the city. (Code 1971, § 5-1)

Sec. 6-21. APPROVAL OF COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

No building permit issued under this article shall become effective or valid until the same has been approved, in writing, by the county health department for sanitary facilities and water supply. (Code 1971, § 5-2)

Sec. 6-22. VIOLATIONS

Violations under this article, including the Standard Building Code, shall be subject to the penalties of section 1-10. (Code 1971, § 5-16)
